

Heath Village is currently experiencing a COVID 19 Outbreak. Visitation in The Meadows and Mayflower House is allowable as long as these procedures are followed.

Visitation procedure:

For Short term/sub-acute patients - Each SAR patient will be allowed to have a maximum of 2 visitors in the room at one time. Visitation can be 7-days per week. (No scheduling necessary but it is recommended to visit in the afternoon, so it does not interfere with rehab). All visitors must wear a mask at all times while visiting and follow screening process noted below. If there is a sign regarding isolation precautions outside the patient's door you are visiting, please see the nurse for further instructions prior to entering.

FOR LTC residents/Mayflower House residents – No need to schedule. Can visit 7 days a week, will be allowed to have a maximum of 2 visitors in the room at one time. All visitors must wear a mask at all times.

- Screening for COVID 19 and PPE use/ mask is mandatory.
- Rapid testing. (Testing is offered but not mandatory).
- > Informed consent form is signed when visitors check in.
- Only two visitors at a time will be allowed and the visit must take place in the patient's room.
- 1. Advance entry kiosk is available at the entrance of the following:
 - Laurel Place for Laurel Place
 - Willow Lane for Hickory Lodge
 - Chestnut Lane for Balsam Cottage
 - Administration entrance
 - Mayflower House entrance

(The Screening Kiosk is available at the vestibule of the households noted above. COVID 19 screening, temperature scanning, touchless response, and ID verification must be completed upon entry. If a kiosk is not available a paper screening form is provided.

When screening is successfully completed, a pass with name and present date will be generated. Please wear a pass while visiting.

(Note: Heath Village residents can screen in at either building. ALL employees to make sure any visitors have a screening sticker/or visitor pass to be able to be in the building).
